Sealed tenders are invited for the <u>Construction of Visitor Vehicle Parking Near Gate No -1 of the Institute.</u> from the eligible companies / Firms/ contractors/agencies, having experience of the similar works(s), with estimated cost of Rs. 9.54 Lakhs. The interested companies / firms / contractors / agencies, who are qualified as per eligibility conditions of the tender, given in the tender form, may submit their tenders in the prescribed format along with EMD and required documents, by speed post or registered post or by hand, so as to reach / drop in the tender box at the receipt / Despatch Section at 1 st floor in Admn. Block' of ABV-IIITM Gwalior by 04:00 PM on 13 th January 2025.

The tender-application form fee is NIL and the same containing detailed specifications, terms and conditions etc., are available on the website of Institute www.iiitm.ac.in, which may be downloaded for submission.

(A.) ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- 1. The Bidding Agencies are required to submit the annexure in the given format along with the copies of following documents, duly signed/self-attested, with the technical bid for being declared to be eligible:-
- I. <u>EMD of Rs. 19800/-</u> (Rs. Ninteen Thousand eight Hundred only) in the form of Demand Draft in favor of "Director ABV-IIITM Gwalior, payable at Gwalior.
- II. Certificate of incorporation of the bidder (Copy of Certificate to be enclosed).
- III. **CGST/SGST Registration** (Certificates to be enclosed along with GST returns of the preceding one quarter.)
- IV. Income Tax Permanent Account Number (**PAN**). (Copy of PAN card to be enclosed.)
- V. The average annual financial turnover during the last three (3) years, ending 31st March 2024 should be at least 30 % of the estimated cost. (Furnish copies of these **three years Income Tax returns**).
 - 2. Experience of having successfully completed Similar type of Civil works, for fabrication of heavy steel structures, during last 5 preceding years(up to November 2024) in Government department(s) /PSU(s)/ reputed Educational Institute(s) by either of the following: -
 - (a). Three civil works completed each costing not less than the amount equal to 40% the estimated cost.
 - (b). Two civil works completed each costing not less than the amount equal to 50% the estimated cost.
 - (c). One civil work completed costing not less than the amount equal to 80% the estimated cost.

- 3. The Bidder(s) need to have its own Bank Account. (Details of Bank Account to be enclosed).
- 4. A declaration to the following effect is required to be submitted on the affidavit of Non-Judicial Stamp of Rs.100 /- that
 - There is no pending criminal case before any Court of law against the Proprietor/Firm/Partner on the bidder company.
 - The bidder has not defaulted from the payment of statuary dues like EPF, ESIC, GST, Income Tax etc. during the last three financial years.
 - The bidder is not blacklisted by any of the following:
 - Government department(s), PSU(s), Organization(s), Educational Institute(s), Autonomous Institute(s) during the last three financial years.
 - No contract of the Bidder has been terminated before expiry of term during the last three financial years.
 - No near relative of the proprietor/ partners/ directors of the firm is working as employee in ABV IIITM Gwalior

(B.) PROCEDURE FOR TENDER SUBMISSION1

.Tenders are required to be submitted in a main sealed cover super scribed "Construction of Visitor Vehicle Parking Near Gate No -1 of the Institute." and it has to be dropped in the Tender Box kept in the Receipt / dispatch section at First Floor of Admn. Block ABV-IIITM Gwalior by 4:00 PM on or before 29 th December 2024.

All papers related to eligibility and EMD shall be kept in envelop marked "A" Technical bid and only Financial bid is to be kept in envelop "B' marked financial Bid same can also be sent by Speed-Post / registered post by clearly mentioning the above subject on Envelope and in such cases, it would be responsibility of the bidder that the same is reached to the Institute by 4:00 PM on or before 13 th January 2025.

- 1. All pages of the Bid shall be duly numbered and self-attested by the bidder.
- 2. Xerox copies of all the submitted documents shall be self-attested.
- 3. Conditional Bids will not be accepted.
- 4. At any time prior to the opening of bids, the Institute may for any reason modify the tender document by suitable amendment/corrigendum(s) through website of the Institute. No separate communication will be required to be sent to prospective bidders.
- 5. The bidders will comply with the terms and conditions mentioned in the tender document and accordingly clearly fill all the columns in both the formats (Technical & Financial), failing which the Institute reserves the right to reject the same.
- 6. Incomplete filled-in tenders shall be rejected.
- 7. The bid shall be opened as scheduled in the Notice Inviting Tender (NIT), in the presence of bidders or their authorized representatives, if any.
- 8. In case, there is a Public Holiday on the scheduled date/day of opening the bid, the same shall be opened on the next working day at the same time.
- 9. The bidders are expected to visit the site at the Institute to inspect the proposed work and be aware of the site conditions and scope of work, which is to be declared in the tender form.
- 10. No correspondence shall be made with those bidders, whose bids are rejected on technical or financial basis.

(C.) GENERAL CONDITIONS OF THE CONTRACT

- 1. The estimated measurement of repair work in proposed work is given merely as a rough guide. The quantity and items mentioned in the schedule may therefore vary, which will have tobe accepted by the contractor in the offered rates. The payments shall be made to the agency as per actual measurement of work executed at site.
- 2. The payment shall be made to the contractor on satisfactory completion of the work and the contractor shall prepare computerized bills as per prescribed format of Tax invoices.
- 3. Before using the material, the contractor shall get approval from the Institute and any changes to the work will require approval from the Institute.
- 4. After communication regarding award of work, the successful bidder shall, within 7 days, submit a non-judicial stamp of Rs. 100/- and sign an agreement with the Institute for the work, on the terms & conditions of the present tender.
- 5. The successful bidder also deposit requisite Performance Security @ 10% of contract value by Demand Draft or Fixed Deposit in the name of Director, ABV-IIITM, Gwalior, which shall be valid at least for a period of Eighteen (18) months.
- 6. EMD of unsuccessful bidders will be returned after finalization of tender. No interest shallbe payable on such refund.

- 7. The Performance Security shall be refunded after 12 Months defect liability period from the date of successful completion of work and satisfaction of the Institute. No interest shall be payable on such refund. Defect Liability will be for any Cracks, Defects or Structural defects or any problem occurred in done work is of 1 Year to which contractor Firm/Agency will visit the site(s) and duly attend such problems.
- 8. The bidders shall quote their rates as per various terms and conditions given in the tender document under price bid, inclusive of all taxes, appropriate materials, labor, machinery, machines tools and plants and all appliances whatsoever are necessary for the complete execution of the work. Nothing extra shall be paid by Institute other than those quoted in the financial bid, if scope of extra/lead or contingency work is not approved by the Director of the Institute.
- 9. All the required labor will be arranged by the contractor only and no minor shall be engaged at site. For all intents and purposes, the unskilled labor and such-like personnel provided by the contractor shall be the employees of the contractor and ABV-IIITM shall not own any responsibility in any manner whatsoever for the same.
- 10. The competent authority of the Institute reserves right to accept the whole or any part of the tender and the contractor shall be bound to perform the same at the quoted rates.
- 11. The tender for the works shall remain open for acceptance for a period of **180 days**.
- 12. The work shall be completed within **20 days** from the date of agreement and intimation regarding commencement of work will be made by the contractor to the Institute.
- 13. A penalty @ Rs. 500/- per day will be imposed for delay, which shall be deducted from the bill of the contractor and the penalty so imposed shall not exceed 5% of the total cost. If any hurdle arises, the same may be intimated to the office of Dean of planning and Development and accordingly, extension of time-period shall be made, if required.
- 14. The work shall be carried out as per CPWD specifications and CPWD Works Manual up to the entire satisfaction of the Institute.
- 15. No waste/ debris of any sort including dismantled material, including dismantled material, will be left at the work site or anywhere in the Institute campus and the contractor shall be responsible to remove and dispose it outside the campus at their own cost.
- 16. The contractor will be fully responsible for any type of loss to the Institute property during execution of work. If any damage is caused at the site or surroundings, the same shall be made good within the quoted rates without any additional payments on this account.
- 17. The contractor shall raise the Bill as per actual work carried-out at site. Any item of work exceeding the quantity specified in this tender document shall require prior written permission of the Institute. The payment shall be made to the contractor on receipt of bills in duplicate and upon satisfaction of the Institute with respect to the entire work.
- **18.** Debarred/blacklisted agency/firm/ individual shall not be permitted to participate in the tendering process.
- 19. The sub-contracting shall not be allowed.
- 20. If the contractor fails to complete the work as per work order up to the satisfaction of the Institute, or commits breach of any of the terms and conditions of contract, then the Institute shall have right to forfeit EMD and/or performance security / guarantee, as the case may be. In addition, the Institute shall have the right to blacklist the contractor.
- 21. The contractor will not be entitled for any compensation due to enactment of any law / regulation etc. during the currency of the contract.
- 22. All Taxes on materials or any element of this contract shall be payable by the contractor and the Institute will not entertain any such claim whatsoever in this respect. The contractor's rates shall cater to all such taxes.
- 23. The Institute will deduct income tax and any other tax applicable, at source from all the payments made to the contractor under this contract, in accordance with the provisions of IT Act or any other law as applicable from time to time.

- 24. The contractor shall be fully responsible to observe the labor safety provisions and all risks of loss of or damage to physical and personal loss and death which arise during the execution of work shall be the responsibility of the Contractor.
- 25. Action in case of bad work If it shall appear to that any work has been executed with unsound, imperfect or unskillful workmanship or with materials of any inferior description the Institute may rectify and re-execute the work or remove and replace with others, material or articles complained of as the case maybe at the risk and expense in all respects of the contractor.
- 26. Criteria for work award will ordinarily be the aggregated lowest rates quoted for all the items.
- 27. The Institute reserves the right to ask the justification of quoted rates before award of work.
- 28. The contractor has to follow all electricity rules as amended from time to time and contractor shall be responsible for any mishap due to negligence on his/labor part whatsoever.
- 29. Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with tenders is strictly prohibited and the tenders submitted by the bidders, who resort to canvassing will be liable to rejection.
- 30. The agency will submit in writing to the Institute after complete work is executed and finished.
- 31. All risks of loss of or damage to physical property and of personal injury and death which arise during and in consequence of the performance of the Contract are the responsibility of the Contractor.
- 32. In the event of any dispute between the Institute and contractor, it shall be resolved through mutual discussions between the parties. If it cannot be resolved through discussion.
- 33. Water and power for bonafide use will be available and contractor will have to take metered connection and will have to pay charges for the same.
- 34. Gwalior District will be judicial jurisdiction for all disputes.
