Advertisement for M.S. (JAM/Non-JAM) Odd Sem M.S. Admissions-2025

ABV-IIITM Gwalior invites applications for the M.S. odd semester admission-2025 in **AI and Data Science** offered by the Department of Engineering Sciences. The admission is against the seats vacant after M.S. summer admission-2025 (CCMN). The primary objective of these specialized programs is to equip students with the skills needed to address real-world challenges in various industrial sectors and foster academic excellence by encouraging research in their respective fields. Our newly designed M.S. curricula offer students a broader and more immersive learning experience. This includes access to advanced laboratories and engaging research projects, ensuring a comprehensive education in their chosen areas of expertise.

A. Important Guidelines for the M.S. Application

- The applicants are required to apply through only online, i.e., Google form (application) available at <https://forms.gle/R7RyWReMQ1GHT8Fn8>.
- There is **NO application fee**.
- The priority for admission will be given to applicants with Valid JAM qualifying score and rank. Applicants without Valid JAM qualifying score must appear in written examination (MCQ) and viva-voce. The admission will be given based on performance in written examination and previous academic records against vacant seats. The written test will be based on the syllabus related to JAM MA, MS, PH and elementary mathematics.
- If two students have the same JAM score, then priority will be decided as per the criteria mentioned in the CCMN website (<https://ccmn.admissions.nic.in/>).
- Candidates must bring a copy of their academic credentials, a valid JAM qualifying score card (if any), category certificate (if applicable), at the time of counselling and admission. Originals of all the above documents are required at the time of document verification. Failing which the candidate may not be allowed for the M.S. admission process.
- Candidates need to bring four (04) passport size photographs at the time of counselling and admission.
- Seats are reserved for Economically Weaker Sections (EWS)/Other Backward Class Non-Creamy Layer (OBC-NCL)/Schedule Caste (SC)/Scheduled Tribe (ST), and Person with Benchmark Disability (PwD) categories as per Government of India norms.
- Appearing for M.S. admission-2025 does not guarantee that the candidate will get the admission. It is based on the availability of the vacant seats after the regular admissions through CCMN (M.S. summer admission-2025) and fulfilling the eligibility and selection criteria.
- During the admission process, document verification (JAM and Non-JAM) and written examination (non-JAM candidates) will take place.
- Physically attending the admission-2025 process is mandatory for all applicants. No admission can be offered to any candidate in a virtual mode.
- There will be no acknowledgement/confirmation on filling the online form. There is no screening. All applicants must directly report to the administrative building, ABV-IIITM Gwalior at 10:00 AM sharp, on 23 July 2025.
- Limited accommodation may be available for out-station on payment basis to participants in the M.S. admission process. The current tariff for a room at the Visitor Hostel is available at <https://www.iiitm.ac.in/index.php/en/downloads>. For reservation, please send an email to visitorhostel@iiitm.ac.in.
- The applicants are requested to check the Institute website regularly for updates.
- Institute has right to fill or not fill the seats. The exact vacant seat matrix will be displayed on the Institute's website after the final round of CCMN counselling. Candidates may note that seats other than the vacant seats may also be available during seat allotment process due to

upgradation/withdrawal of existing allottees.

C. Eligibility

- Admission to M.S. program will be governed by the rules and eligibility criteria of the Institute.
- The M.S. programme considers selected preceding degrees/branches and JAM papers (if applicable) for admissions. **Candidate without valid JAM score is also eligible.**
- The following are the **special eligibilities/restrictions** for admission to the above programmes.
 - a) Candidates should have a minimum of 60% marks (or CGPA 6.5 on a 10-point scale) for GEN/EWS/OBC-NCL, whereas 55% marks (or CGPA 6.0 on a 10-point scale) for SC/ST/PwD in the qualifying degree (B.A./B.Sc./B.S./B.Tech. / B.Com.) aggregate of all semesters/years.
 - b) Candidate must have studied Mathematics as one subject in his qualifying degree.
 - c) Candidates should have a valid JAM score in MATHEMATICS (MA)/ MATHEMATICAL STATISTICS (MS)/ PHYSICS (PH)/Other relevant subject paper in JAM.
 - d) If a qualifying degree result is awaited, the candidate should have a minimum of 60% marks (or CGPA 6.5/10) till the pre-final semester and NO existing backlog papers.

D. Admission Process Details:

All the applicants must physically report to the administrative building, ABV-IIITM Gwalior at 10:00 AM sharp, **23/07/2025**. Based on the valid JAM qualifying score, written exam performance and previous academic records (non-JAM) and number of seats available, the committee will recommend the suitable candidates for the admission. Selected candidates will get the admission offer letter from the academic section along with fee and other details. Selected candidate must pay the fee within the stipulated time and reserve the seat.
