Item 61.0	Opening remarks by the Chairperson BoG
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The Chairperson welcomed all the members in 61st (01/20-25) BoG meeting of the Institute and wished them a very happy and successful year 2025. He suggested that ABV-IIITM Gwalior should actively work on application in the different sectors of Indian Industry and research organization such as DRDO, ISRO, etc. to utilize AI for their benefits and competitiveness. He appreciated the effort of the Institute in inviting DG (R&M) of DRDO as chief guest and the successful organization of 27th Foundation Day of the institute. Chairman also emphasized that efforts should be made to organize the AI awareness program and its application in different sector of the society. All the students along-with their faculty advisors should try to develop at least one AI application as part of their study at ABV-IIITM. For this, they can see and explore the syllabus and similar activities being carried out in the best Universities/College of the World like Harvard, Stanford etc.

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Item 61.2	Action Taken Report of 60th (04/2024) BoG Meeting held on 15.10.2024
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The BoG noted the Action Taken Report (ATR) of the 60th (04/2024) BoG meeting held on 15.10.2024. As directed and authorized by the BoG to Director, under Agenda No. 60.15, the Director gave a time period of three (3) months from the date of 60th BoG Meeting i.e. upto 15th January 2025 to Prof. K V Arya for bringing all his past service benefits, as per the rules of Govt. of India, accrued for the services rendered by him at MJP Rohilkhand University, Bareilly and APJ Abul Kalam Technical University, UP (IET Lucknow) to ABVIITM Gwalior for counting of his past services and deciding his case as GPF-cum-Pension-cum-Gratuity Scheme subscriber. It was also decided by the BoG that in the event of failure to bring the service benefits within the time given from his previous employer, his services will have to be treated as NPS subscriber at ABVIITM Gwalior since inception (initial date of joining at ABVIITM Gwalior).

From the records available, it was informed that the Institute did not receive the past service benefits of Prof. K V Arya accrued for the services rendered by him at MJP Rohilkhand University, Bareilly for counting of his past service for GPF-cum-Pension-cum-Gratuity Scheme subscriber. Therefore, as per the decision of BoG, the services of Prof. K. V. Arya who joined ABVIITM Gwalior on 01/09/2008 will be treated under National Pension System (NPS) from his date of his joining at the Institute.

The BoG expressed its satisfaction with the work being carried out at the institute.

Item 61.3	Report by Director of the Institute
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Prof Sri Niwas Singh, Director, ABV-IIITM Gwalior welcomed the members of BoG for their constant support in making the decisions for benefit of the institute. He expressed his happiness about the successful year 2024. He informed the house about the various activities in the campus after the 60th BoG meeting as.

1. In 2024, Following major work are done
 - a) Meetings: BoG: 4, FC: 3, Senate: 5, BWC: 5
 - b) Conferences: 4 (55 Lakhs), FDP: 34 (65 lakhs)

2. Six external faculty members have joined the institute. The total strength has become 66 including myself.
3. Placement of students is going on and more than 170+ students are placed so far.

5. Planning to start 3 MTech Programs, 2 MTech-PhD dual degree programs and one MS program on AI and Data Science from academic year 2025-26.

Item 61.12	Legal fees of the Legal Advisor
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The legal advisor of the institute has requested to increase the legal fees for looking after the on going cases in the High court of Madhya Pradesh Gwalior Bench. Currently, the institute is paying the legal fees of Rs 30000 plus expenses of Rs 5000 per case. He has now requested ti increase it to Rs 50000/-plus expenses of Rs 5000/- per case.

The BoG deliberated on the matter and approved the legal fee of Rs 50000.00 plus expenses of Rs. 5000 per case basis.


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Item 61.13	Master Plan of the institute
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The master plan of the institute is very old and many new buildings are built. It needs to revise the master plan as institute is more than 25 years old. A revised master plan of the Institute based on as build structure of facilities is developed by a consultant. Various future buildings and other facilities are planned in the available space considering connectivity and ease of use as prime considerations. The revised master plan was discussed in Institute Deans, Director and Registrar meetings held on 12/09/2024 and provided suggestions have been incorporated. The revised master plan has been presented for consideration in the BWC meeting on 26.12.2024 & approved by BWC. As per the comments of the MOE, the master plan of the Institute was discussed in detail in the 51st FC meeting held on 17 January 2025 which approved and recommended it to BoG for final approval.

The BoG discussed the master plan and approved the same incorporating the suggestions of the FC.

Item 61.14	Increase in family income limit for Merit-cum-Means Scholarship
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It has been observed that the institute is not getting sufficient Merit-cum-Means (MCM) scholarship applications due to the family income limit up to Rs 600000. To attract and benefit more students, it is proposed to increase the family income limit from Rs 600000 to Rs 800000 for Merit-cum-Means scholarship of Category -II of MCM scholarship (ie. Rs 3000/- per month to 41 students). It will not increase the financial liability on the institute.

The BoG considered the agenda and approved the same.

Item 61.15	To approve the proposal for establishment of Post Doctoral Fellowship (PDF) Program
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The institute plans to initiate Post-Doctoral Fellowship (PDF) Program from 2025. Rules and regulations for Post-Doctoral Fellowship (PDF) Program for the institute have been framed by a committee constituted for this purpose. It is recommended by the Senate. The Rules and regulations as approved by the Senate are attached as **Annexure-III**

The BoG approved the rules and regulations proposed for Post-Doctoral Fellowship (PDF) Program from the AY 2025. It was also advised by the BoG that the subjects/topics chosen by the PDF along-with the concerned faculty member of the institute must have patentable study and research area.

Item 61.16	Committee proposed for selection of faculty in HAG Scale
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In the institute there are 3 HAG professors, and 3 more vacancies are there as per norm. Since there is no specific rule for selection of HAG professors. In a CFTI Directors' meeting, the following committee is proposed for the selection of faculty in HAG scale.

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As per Section 27 of IIITs Act, 2014, the constitution of a Committee, with the prior approval of the Central Government, to evaluate and review the performance of the Institute in achievements of its objectives, within five years from the establishment and incorporation under the Act and thereafter at the expiration of every fifth year is to be done

The Committee shall consist of members of acknowledged repute in academia or industry, drawn from such fields of knowledge as may have relevance to teaching, learning and research in the Institute. The recommendations of the Committee along with action taken report or proposed to be taken shall be submitted to the Central Government.

1. Preamble

The primary goal of a Post-Doctoral Fellowship (PDF) Program is to develop professional and academic skills under the mentorship of an experienced researcher. The PDF Program at ABV-Indian Institute of Information Technology and Management, Gwalior (ABV-IIITM, Gwalior) aims to identify and motivate young researchers and provide them support for research in frontier areas of science, engineering, technology and management. There are two categories under this program, as given below:

- 1.1. **Institute Post-Doctoral Fellow (IPDF)** - A Post-Doctoral Fellow admitted to the PDF Program of ABV-IIITM, Gwalior, through the procedures adopted by the Institute and avails fellowship from the Institute funds. The number of sanctioned IPDF positions is 02 per department * 05 departments = 10 per year, which can vary as per Institute policy from time to time. However, the number of Post-Doctoral Fellows allotted to any department in any admission cycle depends on the number of suitable candidates and mentors in the department, and unfilled seats of one department may be given to another department by the competent authority.
- 1.2. **External Funding based Post-Doctoral Fellow (EFPDF)** - A Post-Doctoral Fellow admitted to the PDF Program of ABV-IIITM, Gwalior, through the procedures adopted by the Institute and avails Fellowship from any recognized funding agencies like ANRF, CSIR, DST, etc.

ABV-IIITM, Gwalior, provides an opportunity to young researchers as an Institute Post-Doctoral Fellow (IPDF) and External Funding-based Post-Doctoral Fellow (EFPDF).

2. Essential requirements for IPDF

- 2.1. The applicant should be an Indian national with a PhD or equivalent doctorate degree (e.g., D.Sc.) awarded from a recognized Institute/University. The candidate must have secured at least a 6.5 CGPA on a 10-point scale grading system or 60% marks at the Bachelor's and Master's level from a recognized Technical Institute or University in a relevant discipline. CGPA/Percentage relaxation is allowed as per GOI norms. Candidates with a PhD Thesis submitted may also apply. However, the candidate must produce the certificate of award of a PhD Degree from their University/Institute before joining the PDF program.
- 2.2. At least one degree from graduation onward or work experience on a regular pay scale/guest faculty should be from CFTIs (preferably, IISc/IITs/IIITs/NITs/IIMs/ISI/IISERs) or a foreign university with QS rank ≤ 500 .
- 2.3. The applicant should apply within 05 (five) years from the date of the award of a PhD degree (i.e., Defense date).
- 2.4. The applicant, who has completed their PhD from ABV-IIITM, Gwalior, can apply for the IPDF program after 01 (one) year of completion of their PhD defense viva-voce approval date.
- 2.5. Applicants must have at least 03 (three) publications in SCI/SSCI/SCIE indexed Q1 journals as per the latest Journal Citation Report.
- 2.6. There shall be a rolling advertisement for the PDF Program. The applicant should be at most 35 years of age at the time of submission of the application form. However, age relaxation is provided as per the norms of the Govt. of India.
- 2.7. Applicants working as regular employees in government/semi-government/PSU organizations









must apply through proper channel or produce a No Objection Certificate (NOC) from the employing organization at the time of presentation/interview.

3. Selection criteria and process for appointing IPDF

- 3.1. The Institute level committee, constituted by the competent authority, will look into framing/amending the PDF Program guidelines, advertising, and preparing the department-wise seat allocation of the sanctioned seats with the approval of the competent authority.
- 3.2. The initial vacancy is 02 PDFs per department per year that can be modified from time to time as faculty strength increases.
- 3.3. Applications from aspiring Post-Doctoral Fellows will be invited in a prescribed application form; the mentioned documents and a research proposal must support it at submission.
- 3.4. The research proposal submitted by the applicant must not be a mere extension of their PhD work. The expertise brought in by the applicant will be an important criterion in the selection process. Emphasis shall be given to the research proposal's novelty, outcome and implications.
- 3.5. Selection will be made at the institute level.
 - 3.5.1. The Institute Post-Doctoral Selection Committee (IPDSC) will scrutinize the preliminary scrutiny.
 - 3.5.2. The shortlisted candidates must appear for the presentation/interview by a committee approved by the competent authority, ABV-IIITM, Gwalior.
- 3.6. The mentor will be decided by the competent authority in consultation with the HOD of the department concerned.

4. Period of engagement

- 4.1. The appointment of IPDF is purely a temporary and full-time assignment. The duration of the fellowship is 02 (two) years. However, the offer will initially be made for one year and is extendable to a maximum of up to two years based on performance evaluation.
- 4.2. A Progress Monitoring Committee (PMC) will evaluate the progress half-yearly based on quantifiable outcomes referencing the proposed deliverables and publications and recommend the extension accordingly. The extension of the fellowship shall be based on the recommendations of the PMC.
- 4.3. The continuation of the IPDF depends on a satisfactory report of the PMC. The IPDF may be terminated prematurely if the report is unsatisfactory.
- 4.4. The duration of EFPDF will be as per the sponsoring agency's guidelines.

5. Work assignments for IPDF

- 5.1. IPDF will be attached to the department and mentor(s) for carrying out full-time research in the approved area and other academic responsibilities, e.g., tutorial classes, laboratory work, conducting seminars and symposia. However, academic responsibilities must be at most 08 (eight) hours per week.
- 5.2. In addition to carrying out quality research work, the IPDF is expected to assist the mentor(s) in writing externally funded project proposals.
- 5.3. IPDFs shall be eligible to co-guide B. Tech./M. Tech. students in BTP and MTP along with their mentor with the approval of the Dean of Academics Affairs on recommendations from the mentor, HOD and Dean of Research and Consultancy.









5.4. IPDF shall be required to submit a comprehensive progress report to the Dean of Research and Consultancy office at the end of each semester.

6. Targets to be achieved during the period of engagement

- 6.1. The Post-Doctoral Fellow must have a minimum of 01 (one) manuscript submitted in the SCI/SSCI/SCIE indexed Q1 journals in the 1st year along with the mentor. In the 2nd year, 01 (one) paper must be accepted in SCI/SSCI/SCIE indexed Q1 journals, and another paper must be submitted.
- 6.2. The Post-Doctoral Fellow will submit a half-yearly progress report to the PMC describing the research work carried out and research results, supported by reprints or proofs or manuscripts of the papers/patents published or accepted for publication for this purpose.
- 6.3. Further extension of the Post-Doctoral Fellow will be based on quantifiable outcomes and deliverables proposed in the initial proposal and the recommendations of the PMC.
- 6.4. The fellowship of the IPDF shall be revised yearly by the competent authority on the recommendation of the PMC.
- 6.5. The fellowship of a PDF may be terminated at any time if the research progress/conduct of the candidate is unsatisfactory by giving one month's notice to the PDF on the mentor's recommendation, forwarded through HOD and approved by the Dean of Research and Consultancy. Similarly, the PDF must give one month's notice through the mentor, forwarded through HOD and approved by the Dean of Research and Consultancy if they want to leave the fellowship before tenure completion.
- 6.6. The Institute will own any rights related to the Intellectual Property (IP) generated out of post-doctoral research and will be governed by the Institute's IPR policy, which may be amended from time to time.

7. Eligibility to be mentor for IPDF

- 7.1. The proposed mentor should have a PhD degree in the relevant discipline with at least 05 (five) years of post-PhD experience in Academia/Research & Development/Industry and be a regular faculty member (Pay level 12 and above in the 7th CPC) at the institute.
- 7.2. The mentor(s) should work in the proposed/similar research area and have a proven record of SCI/SSCI/SCIE publications. The mentor should have at least 10 (ten) publications in the abovementioned indexed journals.
- 7.3. The mentor(s) should have supervised at least 02 (two) PhD students (awarded/thesis submitted) as a principal supervisor and another student awarded/submitted/under supervision.
- 7.4. A mentor will be permitted to have up to 01 (one) fellow at any given time from the IPDF. The opportunity to take IPDF will rotate among the department faculties. If a Post-Doctoral Fellow works under the mentorship of more than 01 (one) mentor, the PDF shall be considered half.
- 7.5. If a Post-Doctoral Fellow leaves or is terminated, that vacancy will be carried forward.

8. Fellowship and Leave rules

- 8.1. A fellowship of Rs. 60,000/- – 70,000/- per month (consolidated) will be offered as shown in Table 1 below, depending upon experience. This fellowship may be revised from time to time.

- 8.2. A contingency grant of Rs. 30,000/- per annum towards purchasing consumables, attending conferences, meeting publication charges, etc., will be made available to the fellow on the mentor's recommendation. Any unused amount will be carried forward to the next year.
- 8.3. Institute accommodation shall be provided against a license fee and other due charges as per institute norms subject to availability. As per GOI norms, HRA will be provided if accommodation is unavailable.
- 8.4. The IPDF will not be eligible to receive any other fellowship from government/non-governmental sources during the period of their engagement.
- 8.5. If the candidate resigns from the postdoctoral fellowship before the expiry of the term, the candidate will have to give either one month's notice or deposit one month's fellowship to the Institute for the same.
- 8.6. Leave rules will be followed as per PhD rules and regulations of the Institute.
- 8.7. IPDF is not a regular position of the institution

9. External Funding based Post-Doctoral Fellowship (EFPDF) program

EFPDF is admitted to the Post-Doctoral Program of ABV-IIITM, Gwalior, through the procedures adopted by the Institute and avails Fellowships from any recognized funding agencies like ANRF, CSIR, DST, etc. For EFPDF, guidelines of the sponsoring agency will be applicable.

10. Power to Modify

Chairperson, Senate is empowered to make any change(s)/Amendment(s)/Exception(s) in the regulations of the Post-Doctoral Fellowship (PDF) program from time to time.
