Individual Requests Received for Various Academic Related Matter

- 1. **Mr. Bhupendra Meena (Roll No. 2014IPG-030)** has not cleared course "Seminar-II (MG1209)" which was an Audit course during his study.
 - On examination it was revealed that he could not complete the required credits/courses in the maximum permissible seven years and also not requested at that time for continuation of the course. Further, the student left the institute without any information. On his case the decision was already taken in earlier senate meeting. Thus, his request is not considered.
- 2. A request was received from Mr. Vasant Rao (Roll No. 2018BCS-062) to complete his programme by giving an extension of 1 more year. The maximum duration allowed (4+2) years was already over in 2023-24. Taking a sympathetic view the Chairperson Senate had allowed him an extension of six months to complete the courses of odd semester. Senate ratified the approval of Senate Chairperson for an extension of six months. If he clears all the courses for which he has registered during this extended period, he may again request for further extension beyond this six months and Senate will deliberate for the same at that point of time.

The matter was deliberated at length and after examination of all the facts, the Senate did not consider his case and directed that the student should complete all the backlogs first before he could be allowed to register for 3rd Semester.

In case of 5-year Integrated Postgraduate M.Tech., the 4 credits will be carved out of the 12 credits assigned to thesis of 10^{th} semester."

PROFESSOR of PRACTICE

Overview

Leading academic institutes across the globe have appointed Professors of Practice primarily to get benefit of the industry experts and using their experience to enrich students for a better understanding and appreciation of the best practices applied to real-world problems. As an Institute of National Importance (INI), ABV Indian Institute of Information Technology and Management (ABV IIITM) Gwalior recognizes the importance of state-of-the-art technology and the wealth of experience available in the corporate sector. The number of Professors of Practice would typically be 10-15% of the faculty at the Institute and each department will have up to TWO Professors of Practice at any given time.

Expectation

Professors of Practice is expected to teach in different programs as per the norms of the Institute; to take part in academic administration and promotion of industry-institute linkages through wide range of activities. These individuals would ideally provide students with a better understanding of the various technology application domains of social good.

Eligibility

Candidates should have at least 15 years of professional experience and should have worked in senior management positions such as CEO/CTO/VP/Director/Head/Lead for at least five years. They should have at least a master's degree in engineering/ sciences/ management or in a relevant field. Ph.D. is desirable but not essential. However, a lack of Ph.D. must be offset by demonstrated domain knowledge, obtained from deep experience in the concerned field.

Duties

The Professor of Practice is expected to perform a wide range of duties including:

- 1. Design, development and offering of new practice-oriented courses
- 2. Advise students in their projects linking them with appropriate external stake holders
- 3. Encourage students in innovation and entrepreneurship projects and provide necessary mentorship for their activities
- 4. Engage in industry academia collaborations
- 5. Supervision of master's students in their research and serve as co-supervisor for Ph.D. scholars.

Appointment and Benefits

All appointments for Professor of Practice are of contractual in nature. However, a Professor of Practice can be either on a Regular scale OR on a Consolidated salary or on a part-time basis, depending on whether such candidate is able to stay on campus.

- 1. The allowances, leave and other benefits for a Professor of Practice on a Regular scale/consolidated will be as per Institute norms and the appointment is done through a standing committee as it is being practiced for the appointment of Adjunct Professors. The offer would be for an initial period of TWO years and extendable not beyond the retirement age (as per Institute norms) based on the performance and contributions made.
- 2. In case of appointments made on a part-time basis, the Professor of Practice shall be entitled to receive allowances as applicable to Adjunct Professors. The stay on the campus should be at least for 1 months in a year.
- 3. Appointment is done through a standing committee for two years as it is being practiced for the appointment of Adjunct Professors.
