Prof. Sampat R Vadera, IIT Jodhpur and Prof J Dhar could not attend the meeting and were granted a leave of absence. Chairman, Senate welcomed all the members of the senate, special invitees, and senate secretary. The item-wise agenda points were deliberated and decided as follows:

Item 40.0	Opening remarks by the Chairperson Senate
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Prof Sri Niwas Singh, Chairperson Senate welcomed all the members of the Senate to the 40th (03/2025) Academic Senate meeting. In this meeting, several policy related agenda items and several noting items were discussed. The brief remarks of the Chairperson are as follows:

- All faculty members (6 external) who were selected in May 2025 have joined the institute.
- 219/224 students are placed so far who have CGPA of more than 7.00.
- Institute has organized 20 FDP/workshop/ESDP (Rs **47** lakhs) in the campus during January - June 2025.
- HACKSAGON 2025 (Hardware and software competitions), a national-level hackathon was organized by the IEEE Student Branch, ABV-IIITM Gwalior during June 27-28, 2025. Total **580** students participated in this event.
- **Two** AICTE-QIP PG certificate courses (Data Science and Quantum Computing; Intelligent Transportation System: Synergy of Artificial Intelligence, Drones and EVs), are started on 23 June 2025 (**85 teachers**).
- **Convocation 2025** was successfully organized for passing out batch on 12 July 2025. The total cost incurred **Rs 11.0 lakhs** (approx.) against sanction value of Rs 25.0 lakhs. Dr AK Sood, PSA, GoI and Ms K. Malleswari, VC Sports University Delhi, were honored with the DSc (Honoris Causa) degrees. Prof Abhay Karandikar, DST secretary, was the Chief guest.
- As per **NIRF 2025**, the Institute ranked **93** in management and **96** in engineering. No other IITs (CF or PPP) got rank within 100.
- **45** non-teaching posts are approved by ministry. The BoG has approved faculty positions from 120 to **148**.
- Institute is successful in attracting students towards Master's degree programmes: MTech- **103 out of 118**, MS (AI & DS)- 32 out of 35 were admitted.
- **354 new UG/IPG students, 10 DASA and 8 SII** students have reported for admission during AY 2025-26.
- 29 PhD students have joined. As on date, the institute has **152** PhD students.
- Two institute PDFs and one Visvesvaraya PDF have been joined in various departments of the institute.
- Institute organized/planned following major events during 2025:
 - Faculty development program for ABV-IIITM Faculty (mandatory for Assistant Professors) was conducted by NITTTR Bhopal during July 21-25, 2025, in the institute.
 - India-Euro International Centre of Cooperation for Excellence organized the international workshop on Smart Agriculture & Digital Rural Technology during August 29-30, 2025, at IIT Delhi jointly organized by IITD, ABV-IIITM and others.
 - ABV-IIITM Gwalior, MPCST Bhopal and VIBHA Gwalior organized Tech4Seva (Major is theme: Agriculture) during 12-14 September at ABV-IIITM Gwalior.
 - ABV-IIITMG Students' mega event, INFOTSAV, is being planned during October 10-12, 2025.
 - International Conference on Mathematical and Computational Frontiers for Sustainable Development (MATHSD 2025), Engineering Science Department will be held during 16 – 17 October 2025.
 - Inter IIIT staff sports meet is scheduled during November 1-4, 2025, at ABV-IIITM Gwalior.

- 2nd IEEE International Conference INSPECT-2025 by Electrical & Electronics Engineering Department will be held during 7-8 November 2025
- 4th Atal Research and Innovation Conclave (ARIC) will be organised during November 14-15, 2024.
- 4th International Conference on Advances in Nanomaterials and Devices for Energy and Environment (CANDEE-2025) is scheduled during November 16-18, 2025.
- IEEE International Conference on Recent Advances in Computing and Systems (ReACS 2025) will be organized by Computer Science Engineering Department during 19 – 20 December 2025.
- 5th International Conference on Advanced Networks, Technologies and Intelligent Computing (ANTIC 2025) will be organized by Information Technology Department during 21-23 December 2025.
- Selection committee meetings have been planned during 7-9, October 2025 for Faculty recruitment (special drive for EWS and SC/ST). Advertisements of Registrar, DR, AR (legal), Sr TO, and TO have been done. The selection process for the promotion of non-faculty will be completed before next BoG.

Item 40.21	Admissions in Ph.D. through Non-GATE/NET in Department of EEE, CSE & IT
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The Senate approved the Ph.D. admissions for the Non-GATE applicants in Engineering departments (EEE/CSE/IT) with written test followed by interview, in addition to the already existing rules, and other conditions.

The guidelines for Non-GATE PhD Admission are as below:

i) For GATE/NET Qualified Applicants: (As per the existing ordinance)

- (a) An applicant having a master's degree in engineering/technology/electronics/mechatronics or any other equivalent qualification² (MSc/MCA/MS in relevant field/branch and 10+2 with mathematics) recognized by the Institute with a minimum of 60% marks or CGPA of 6.5 on a 10-point scale in the qualifying degree. Additionally, the applicants must have qualified for the GATE/NET examination.
- (b) Applicants, who have only B.Tech. degree, are also eligible for the Ph.D. admission subject to 75% marks or 8.0 CGPA in B.Tech. with a valid GATE Score.
- (c) The requirement for GATE can be exempted for applicants having B.Tech. or equivalent degree from Centrally Funded Technical Institutions (CFTIs) with CGPA 8.0 or above at B.Tech. level.

ii) For Non-GATE/NET Applicants:

- (a) An applicant having a master's degree in engineering/technology/electronics/mechatronics or any other equivalent qualification² (MSc/MCA/MS in relevant field/branch and 10+2 with mathematics) recognised by the Institute with a minimum of **75% marks or CGPA of 8.0 on a 10-point scale** in the qualifying degree will be considered against the vacant seats after filling the seats from Gate/NET applicants.
- GATE/NET Qualified applicants will appear for Presentation/Interview and Non-GATE/NET applicants must appear for the Institute's PhD Admission Written Test and Presentation/Interview.
- The total seats for PhD admission in all the departments will be 100 in an academic year.

Item 40.24**Revision in selection criteria for 2 years PG-MBA Programme**

The Senate approved the proposal to revise the eligibility and selection criteria for 2 years PG-MBA Programme for the academic year 2026-27 as below details:

1) Expansion of the list of testing agencies eligible for admission:

In addition to CAT, inclusion of other recognized national level entrance tests such as MAT/CMAT/ATMA/GMAT/GRE/CUET for eligibility. This expansion aims to broaden the applicant pool and provide wider opportunities for aspiring candidates.

2) Revision of weightage distribution for the admission criteria as:

Item 40.25**Modification in Number of MCM Scholarship to PwD & MSC Students**

From 2025 batch onwards tuition fee waiver has been provided to IMT & IMG PwD students till 4th year of their study. Also there has been an increase in intake for B.Tech in Mathematics and Scientific Computing from 40 to 60.

Therefore, one Type-II MCM scholarship provided to IMG & IMT PwD students is added to Type-II MCM scholarship for B.Tech in Mathematics and Scientific Computing from 2025 batch onwards.

Item 40.26**Request for admission of Ms. Diya Tharani in MBA Program**

The Senate examined the case of Ms. Diya Tharani for admission in MBA program during ongoing session after she passed the Bachelor's examination through her letter dated 12/09/2025.


