Item 64.0	Opening remarks by the Chairperson BoG
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The chairman, BoG welcomed all the members of the committee in the 64th (04/2025) BOG meeting of the Institute. He expressed his happiness for the institute being under 100 in NIRF ranking 2025 as no IIITs (CF or PPP) are in first 100 ranks. However, he said that the institute must go a long way in all fields.

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The minutes of the meeting of 63rd (03/2025) BoG held on 11.07.2025 at ABV-IIITM Gwalior were circulated to the members, and no comments were received.

Item 64.2	Action Taken Report on 63rd BoG Meeting held on 11.07.2025
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The BoG noted the Action Taken Report (ATR) of the 63rd (03/2025) BoG held on 11.07.2025 and expressed satisfaction with the works being done at the institute.

Prof Sri Niwas Singh, Director, ABV-IIITM Gwalior, welcomed the members of BoG for their constant support in making the decisions for benefit of the institute. He informed the BoG about the various activities in the campus after the 63rd BoG meeting as:

- Convocation 2025 was successfully organized for passing out batch 2025. The total expenditure was Rs 10.0 lakhs (approx.) against the sanctioned of Rs 25.0 lakhs.
- As per NIRF 2025, the Institute ranked 93 in management and 96 in engineering. No other IITs (CF or PPP) got a rank within 100.
- 45 non-teaching posts are approved by the ministry.
- Institute is very successful in attracting master students: MTech- 103 out of 118, MS (AI & DS)- 32 out of 35.
- 354/360 new UG/IPG students, 11/13 DASA and 8/12 SII students were admitted.
- 31 PhD students have joined. At moment, the institute has 151 PhD students.
- 02 institute PDFs have been selected in two departments. Due to strict requirements, we could not attract more PDF. The matter is being referred to Senate for the same.
- Institute planned following major events during 2025:
 - Faculty development program for ABV-IIITM Faculty (Assistant Professors) was conducted during July 21-25, 2025, in the institute. This was conducted by NITTTR Bhopal.
 - India-Euro International Centre of Cooperation for Excellence organized the international workshop on Smart Agriculture & Digital Rural Technology during August 29-30, 2025, at IIT Delhi, jointly organized by IITD, ABV-IIITM and others.
 - ABV-IIITM Gwalior and MPCT Bhopal are joining in organizing Tech4Seva (Major theme: Agriculture) during 12-14 September at ABV-IIITM Gwalior.
 - International Conference on Mathematical and Computational Frontiers for Sustainable Development (MATHSD 2025), Engineering Science Department, 16 – 17 October 2025
 - 2nd IEEE International Conference INSPECT-2025 by Electrical & Electronics Engineering Department during 7-8 November 2025
 - 4th Atal Research and Innovation Conclave (ARIC) will be organized on Nov 14-15, 2024.
 - 4th International Conference on Advances in Nanomaterials and Devices for Energy and Environment (CANDEE-2025) is scheduled during November 16-18, 2025.
 - IEEE International Conference on Recent Advances in Computing and Systems (ReACS 2025) will be organized by the Computer Science Engineering Department during 19 – 20 December 2025.
 - 5th International Conference on Advanced Networks, Technologies and Intelligent Computing (ANTIC 2025) Organized by the Information Technology Department during 21-23 December 2025.
- Selection committee meetings will be held during October for Faculty recruitment (special Drive for EWS, SC/ST). The selection process for the promotion of non-faculty will be completed before next BoG.

Update on sanction of new non-faculty posts and distribution of posts for promotion and direct recruitment as per RPN 2016

An email dated 15th July 2025 has been received from the MoE regarding the approval of 45 new posts of non-faculty at different levels. The BoG approved the distribution of posts for direct recruitment and promotion of the non-faculty posts as per RPN 2016.

Item 64.6

Approval of Roster for Non-faculty positions

As per reservation policy of Government of India, the Rosters for recruitment of faculty and non-faculty were prepared and approved by the BoG in its 47th and 48th meeting held on 02.07.2022 & 22.09.2022 for consideration and approval.

The new 45 posts of the non-faculty have been approved by the Department of Expenditure at various levels. The roster has been prepared and is put up in the meeting for consideration and approval.

The BoG approved the same. The Chairman enquired about the current position of the recruitment of reserve positions and observed that the institute needs to do better in this area. He instructed director to do his best also to ensure the “equal opportunity” principle applied in the recruitment process.

Nomination of one FC Member

As per the provisions of the 18 (1) (d) of IIIT Act 2014, The BoG approved the term of Prof. A.K. Mittal, ex-Professor, IIT Kanpur, for three years.

The BoG approved the same.

Item 64.8

Guidelines for the selection of non-faculty promotions and direct recruitment (other than Registrar, DR, AR, STO, MO, TO and ASO)

To streamline and standardize the process with a view to ensuring a transparent, uniform and merit-based recruitment/selection process for fresh appointment to the administrative and technical cadre posts in the institute (Group A to Group C) and promotion of existing incumbents are needed as per RPN 2016. A committee prepared the comprehensive procedure/guidelines for conducting written test, trade test, presentations and/or interviews for appointments of administrative and technical cadre post (Group A to C) in accordance with the norms of RPN 2016 and the guidelines as prescribed by the DoPT. The procedure for Registrar, DR, AR, STO, TO, MO and ASO has already been approved by the BoG.

The BoG approved the selection of the non-faculty promotions and direct recruitment as proposed.

Item 64.9	Approval of Selection of Assistant Registrar on Promotion			
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The sealed envelope received from the selection committee for the post of Assistant Registrar (through promotion) was opened in the meeting and the Board was apprised regarding the recommendations of the selection committee. The following candidate was selected for the post of Assistant Registrar (through promotion) at Level 10.

The Board approved the selection of the Assistant Registrar (through promotion).

The BoG also recommended to do the promotion of all other eligible employee of the institute as per the RPN 2016.

Item 64.10	Permission for the direct recruitment of Registrar, Deputy Registrar and Assistant Registrar
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Registrar selected in the previous advertisement did not join, and therefore, the wait-listed candidate was offered the post. Waitlisted candidates also did not join. One new Deputy Registrar position is also sanctioned.

A new post for Deputy Registrar and two Assistant Registrars (one on promotion and one on direct recruitment) have been sanctioned. There are a lot of legal cases in the institute and expected to be more in the future as the strength is increasing. Therefore, it is suggested to recruit an Assistant Registrar (Legal).

The BoG approved the direct recruitment of Registrar (one post), Deputy Registrar (one post), and Assistant Registrar (Legal) (one post).

Item 64.11	Approval of Faculty Positions and Roster
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The BoG with provision provided in IIIT Act 2014 (section 15(2) (e)) is requested to approve the faculty position in the ratio of 1:12 on total student strength of students as per 1st IIIT Council Meeting held on 7th April 2015 notified by MHRD f.No.77-1/2015-TS.1 dated 8th May 2015.

The BoG in its 47th meeting held on 02.07.2022 approved the faculty positions of 120 (Professor: 45, Associate Professor: 30 and Assistant Professor: 55). Out of 120 faculty positions, 71 are filled and selection of faculty positions are continuously going on.

The faculty required at present based on total students' strength of 1780 is 148 (one hundred forty-eight only). The distribution under 4-tier flexible cadre (Professor: 48; Associate Professor: 30; and Assistant Professor (Grade I & II): 70) is placed before the BoG for consideration and approval. The details of existing positions, filled and vacant, etc. is given in Annexure I.
