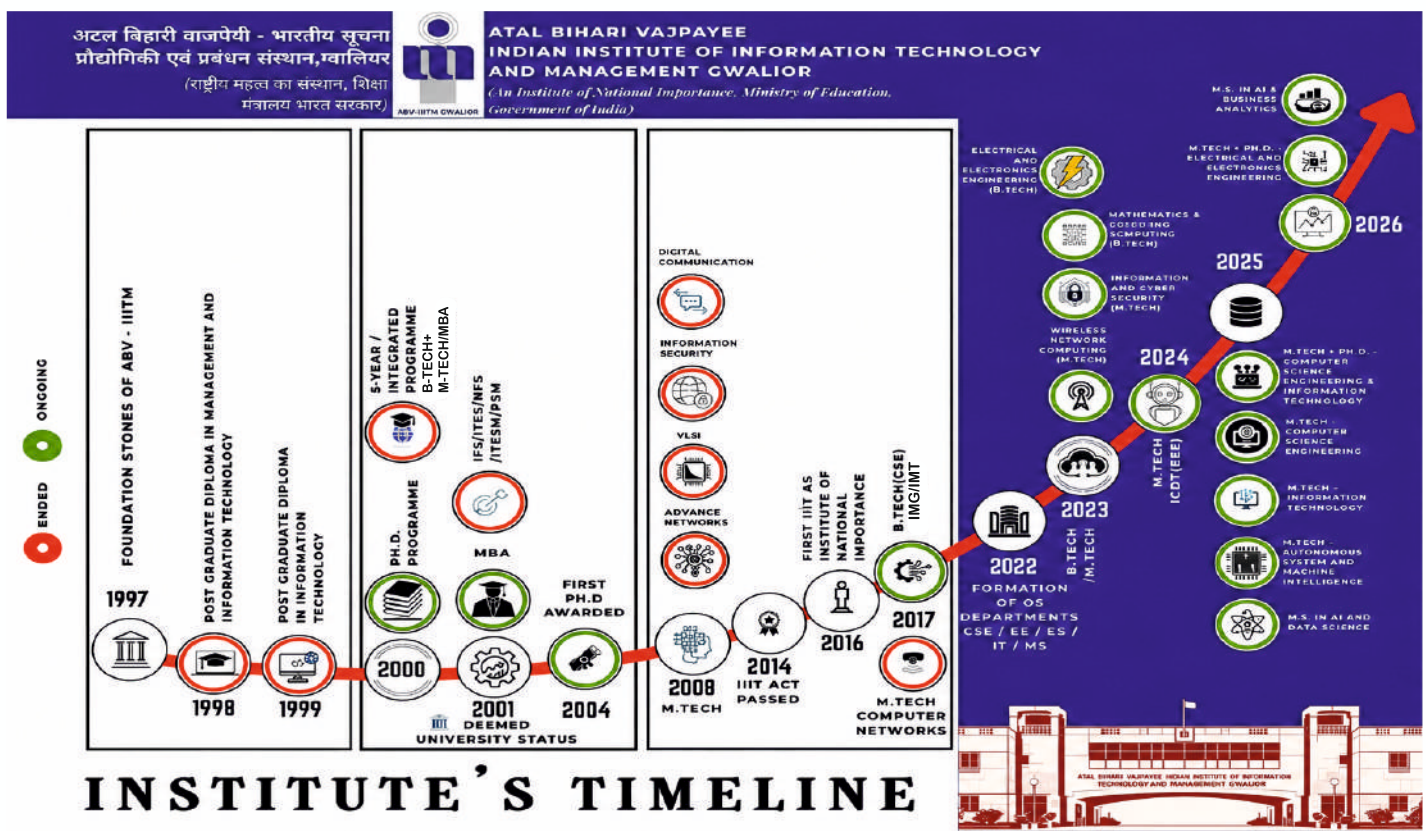

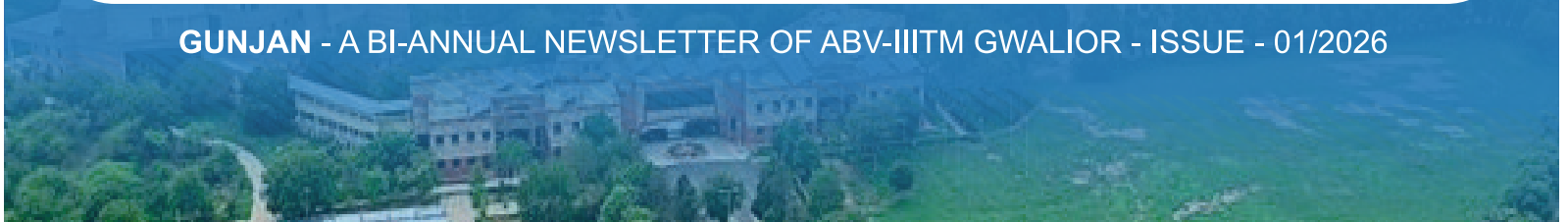

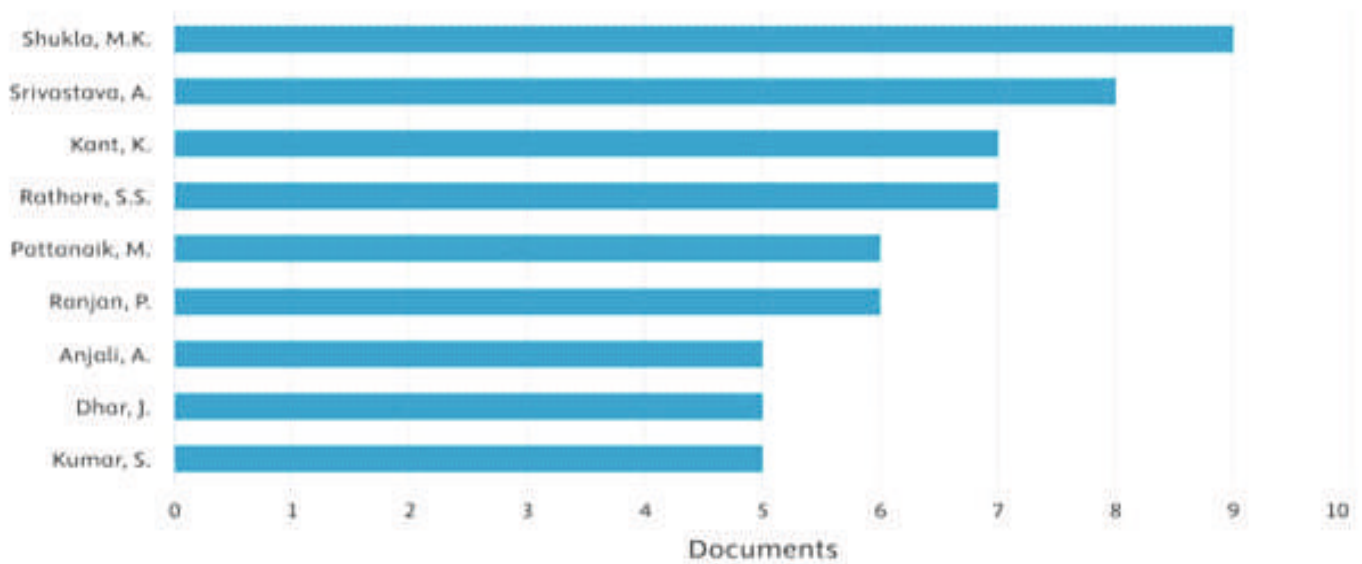


Research Area Wise Publications and the respective Count

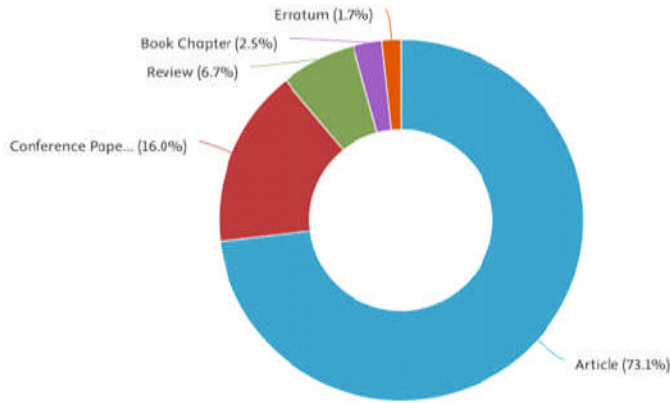

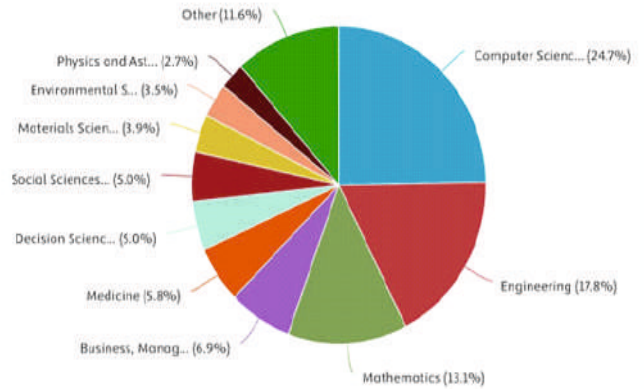
